



### **V8** Times Magazine

Here is a little information regarding the digital-only membership:

The digital-only membership gives you access to the V-8 Times via the internet. If you select the digital-only membership you will <u>not</u> receive the V-8 Times magazine or Club Roster in the mail. With the digital-only membership you can access the current magazine from your phone, tablet, computer, etc. The September/October issue is currently posted, and as new issues are available, they will be added to the list of issues that you will be able to see on the website.

New issues of the digital version of the V-8 Times will be available after the magazine goes to the publisher for printing and mailing. You will be able to see it online <u>before</u> the magazine is delivered in the mail. The digital version of the V-8 Times is scheduled to be posted on the website on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, April, June, August, October, and December. Another feature of the digital-only membership is a digital Club Roster, which is searchable by member's name, city, vehicle make and model.

If you select a membership that includes a magazine delivered in the mail (or have one already), you will also receive access to the digital version of the magazine and roster at no additional cost to you. As an added feature for magazine subscribers, you get all the benefits of the "digital-only" membership plus you receive the magazine and roster in the mail.

The membership that includes the magazine in the mail does not cost much more than the \$30 digital-only membership, at least for members in the United States. If you live in Canada, Australia, New Zealand or Europe, the currency exchange rate and postage make the digital-only particularly attractive. For these members, digital-only membership is much less than paying for a magazine delivered in the mail. These are the members that will most likely select digital-only. It may also be preferable to members that want to read the magazine, but dislike magazines accumulating in their home!

If you are currently a member of the National Club and receive the V-8 Times in the mail, you may view the current issue on-line, right now. Go to the <a href="https://www.earlyfordv8.org/">https://www.earlyfordv8.org/</a>, select "Membership" from the menu on the right side of the screen, then login using your username and password and select "on-line magazine' from the top menu.


