very close, MOV (Margin of Victory) was .3926 seconds. It takes a human about a third of a second to blink, .3000 seconds.





























# Bert Marsh Distinguished Service Award

Jack Eakins passed away a few days ago as the result of cancer. I talked to Jack's wife and their daughter's are planning things. When plans are firmed up, they will let us know.


